Keeping Your Kids on HUSKY B

You need to renew HUSKY health coverage once a year. When you get the HUSKY renewal form, be sure to fill it out and send it back. Your children will probably be able to keep HUSKY even if your income has changed.

If your family income has changed

If your income has gone up, your health care costs (co-payments and premiums) may stay the same or change. If your income has gone down, your costs may go down or your child may get HUSKY A, a free program. If your child can get HUSKY A, you will get a letter saying that your HUSKY application was sent to the Department of Social Services.

When you get your renewal form

- Part of the renewal form is already filled out with what you put in your last application.
- Make sure that the information is right or make changes.
- Fill in any blanks and sign the form. Make a copy for yourself if you can.
- Mail in your form quickly.
- **You will get a form to choose your child's HUSKY health plan with your renewal.** If you want to keep the health plan your child has now, you do *not* have to fill this out.
- If you want to change your child's health plan, fill this out and send it back quickly with the renewal.
